Welcome to L.Y.C. Prep Preschool

We are pleased that you have chosen L.Y.C. Preschool as your child's first adventure in learning! Please feel free to offer us any suggestions. We want to make the most of your child's preschool experience.

L.Y.C. Preschool provides a program in which the child is viewed as a unique and special individual. Each child is encouraged to creatively express his/her feelings through a curriculum that is designed to enrich his/her creative, social, physical, and mental development. We align the Indiana Academic Standards to our program.

Modes of Learning

- 1. By hearing stories and learning finger plays, we are beginning to grow.
- 2. By playing with others, we are learning social development.
- 3. By listening and exploring creative expression, we are learning art and music.
- 4. By running, skipping, hopping, and playing games together, we are developing our gross motor skills and working with others.
- 5. By using puzzles, coloring, cutting, and printing, we are developing our fine motor skills.
- 6. By exposure to the alphabet, we are moving into reading readiness.
- 7. By introducing early math and science concepts like counting, shapes, colors, measurements, and classification, we are learning about comparison and correlation.

Assessment Procedures

School Year Schedule

The 2017-2018 school year will start on Tuesday, September 5, 2017. You will receive a reminder notice in August regarding this start date. The 4 & 5 year old Pre-K class will attend on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday afternoons starting at 11:45am each day and concluding at 2:15pm. The 3 & 4 year old class will attend on Tuesday and Thursday mornings starting at 9am each day and concluding at 11:15am.

Please be sure to call us if your child will not be attending school for any reason.

The L.Y.C. Preschool adheres to the Wawasee Community School Corporation yearly class schedule and will observe all the same holidays and breaks. When the Wawasee Schools are cancelled due to inclement weather, L.Y.C. Preschool will also be closed. However, if there is a two hour weather related delay, L.Y.C. Preschool will operate on the following schedule: the 3&4 year old class will attend school starting at 10:00am and conclude at 12 noon, while the 4&5 year old class will attend from 12:30pm to 2:30pm. You will be able to check for all weather cancellations and delays on TV station WNDU Channel 16 and radio stations WRSW 107.3 and Willie 103.5.

Attendance

Attendance is very important to the success of our program. We ask that you call or email and let us know if your child is going to be absent. Absenteeism without communication for longer than two weeks will excuse your child from our program without a refund for the remaining months paid tuition. This will open a spot for a child on our wait list and we cannot guarantee your child a spot when/if they return.

Tuition/Payment Schedule

All tuition payments are due by the 1st of each month.

Failure to pay by the 10th of each month will result in an additional \$10.00 late fee added to your tuition cost.

If payment is not received in full by the end of the month, you will be considered in arrears. If you neglect to pay the sum in arrears and the following month's tuition by the 10th of the following month your child will be dismissed from school until payment is made.

If you child will be traveling for the winter months or you need to take a month off of preschool you will still have to pay for the month(s) missing class. This insures we hold a spot for your child in class.

You are also required to pay a non-refundable \$50.00 registration fee due by April 13, 2017 to ensure registration into the L.Y.C. Preschool Program.

Disciplinary Procedure Policy

The staff at the L.Y.C. Preschool feels the appropriate use of discipline can be effective for teaching children socially acceptable ways of behaving. Children in our program will not receive physical punishment. Those who have conflicts or problems with others while at school will be encouraged to verbalize their angers and concerns. As their teachers, we will guide them to positive problem solving and will provide solutions and logical consequences. Below are the discipline procedures we will follow.

- 1. Discuss problem with child and reinforce what is acceptable behavior.
- 2. Warning
- 3. Time-Out
- 4. Phone Parent(s)
- 5. Conference with Parent(s)

Transportation Policy

L.Y.C. has adopted a policy that requires any and all people that will be providing transportation to and from school for your child be put on your "Who may pick up my child" list. This will help ensure that no unwanted persons are picking up your child. L.Y.C. will also NOT allow your child to leave with someone who is not on the list.

Vaccinations

L.Y.C. requests that all children age three and up be current on all vaccinations before starting school. This helps prevent sickness for all the children in the school. L.Y.C. does offer free vaccinations by the Kosciusko County Health Department on the second Thursday of every month at 2:00-3:30pm.

Snack and Drink Policy

Every month you will receive a newsletter with important information and a current calendar. On this calendar you will find information regarding snacks and drinks. These are also available on our website! If you are responsible for snack, please send along something healthy. We are trying to teach the children good eating habits and would like to avoid excessive sugar. However, on your child's birthday, a special snack is always welcome. Cookies or ice cream cups are a nice treat. Please do not bring cupcakes as the majority of students do not eat them.
